About the programmme

The International Trade Centre (ITC) is the joint development agency of the World Trade Organization and the United Nations, which enables export-ready businesses and those with export potential in developing and transition countries to increase exports by providing, with partners, sustainable and inclusive trade development solutions to the private sector companies, business support organizations, and policymakers.

This new project in **Sri Lanka** will increase the export competitiveness of selected **textile and clothing (T&C)** manufacturers by improving production, pre-production and post-production capabilities while focusing on sustainability, circularity and digitalization aspects as key competitiveness drivers.
