Title: Norwegian Generalized System of Preference (GSP) Plus Scheme

Date: July 2013

Summary:

The Norwegian GSP scheme provides exporters from Sri Lanka additional duty relief when exporting goods to Norway.

Highlights:

Sri Lanka received "GSP Plus" status with effect from January 2013 and is thus eligible for preferential /duty free access to the Norwegian market for products of Sri Lankan origin under this new "GSP Plus" Scheme.

Benefits granted under "GSP Plus" scheme

In addition to the preferences received under ordinary GSP scheme, Sri Lanka now receives a margin of preference of 50% and 100% on certain agricultural and textile items.

- a. Agriculture goods (HS 01-24) 50 % MOP and Duty free access for selected products falling under HS Chapters 5,7.8,11,15,16,20 & 33.
- b. Industrial Products (HS 25-97) All industrial products exported from Sri Lanka are now Duty free under Norwegian GSP plus scheme. This includes textile items of HS Chapters 61.07- 61.11, 62.01 & 62.01,63.01 & 63.03 which were exempted under ordinary GSP.

Country of Origin (COO)

The originating status of the product must be proven by a satisfactory proof of origin – either by Form A or an Origin Declaration. The COO is issued by Department of Commerce, "Rakshana Mandiraya", 21, Vauxhall Street, Colombo 02, Sri Lanka.
