Sri Lanka Export Development Board (EDB) invites expression of interest from qualified, experienced and eligible Consultant/Firm who is required to closely work with the industry and EDB to carry out a feasibility study on Market, Technical and Financial aspects for creation of business opportunities for lay-up / stacking facilities of vessels & related services in Sri Lankan Harbours with emphasis on Trincomalee Port. It will be a six months' work assignment. The Consultant/Firm would be responsible for the followings.

Scope of work

The consultant / firm will be required to carry out an in-depth study into the feasibility of various aspects of the Marine & Offshore Services sector including Lay-up / stacking facilities of vessels & related services, assess Sri Lanka's current technical capabilities to deliver and analyze gaps where investment & development would be necessary with technical, financial, economic and environmental feasibility of such projects.

The consultant / firm shall be required to provide the results of the Market, Technical and Economic & Financial Feasibility as detailed in the TOR published in www.srilankabusiness.com under the "Announcement". In executing the scope of work, the consultant / firm shall give prominence to the Trincomalee Port.

Requirements

The consultant / firm should

- a) Clearly demonstrate the legal name, organizational structure indicates explicitly Expression of Interest (EOI) in the assignment and demonstrate the understanding of the assignment.
- b) Ownership and registration of the firm.
- c) Financial Statement for last 5 years.
- d) Have at least five (05) years' experiences on consultancy work of similar magnitude with related technical knowledge, internally or with the capability to outsource services of industry recognized consultants in maritime research and consultancy.
- e) Demonstrate a proven track record of undertaking similar assignments and have a well-resourced team that has capacity to deliver the intended results.
